- AHA Jump/Hoops – Gayle

- American Heart 40 years of Jump Great relationship between the two Few years grumbling between AHA and SHAPE SHAPE WA cut was reduced this past year Contract signed last October (later than past years) –

New CEO at SHAPE WA – ask to remove no compete cause, \$ - flat rate every year, AHA said no Gayle prepared the budget without the AHA money

AHA has not shared budget money information – where is the money going? Trademark is co-owned AHA will rebrand – directly w/ superintendents directly and we/SHAPE WA become a competitor w/ them A decision will be made for the new contract by June 1.

Financial Report/Budget – two budgets one w/ one w/o AHA

Only getting a percent of actual PE/Health teachers to become members Outdoor ED conference/Peak/Project Adventure – could that be a summer conference ACCT – governing body for adventure ed, stuff Trauma informed education/Action Based = maybe more classroom Increase ABL

Money spent on printing and mailing for journal = \$6000 Instead hire a consulting for an interactive journal/website More \$ to have a print w/ your membership

Ad Hoc committee, chaired by Dustin Lungo – for funding and increase revenue

Worked on increase membership - auto enroll

Using PLAN more effectively Universal Slide for all SHAPE WA presentations - to promote our membership

Start in the Fall w/ opt in for written journal? Gayle will check into what a hard copy subscription would cost per person Vote on fall membership information and pricing at the fall board meeting
